Instructions for the 2009 APPLICATION

The Nevco Scholar-Athlete Scholarship for full-time study leading to an undergraduate degree is open to students who are attending a high school or who will attend a college that uses a Nevco scoreboard, marquee, message center or video display. The purpose of the Nevco Scholar-Athlete Scholarship is to recognize the achievements of individuals who excel in the classroom and athletic participation by providing financial assistance toward the continuing education of these extraordinary individuals. Individuals who are recipients of the awards will have demonstrated excellence in the classroom, successes on the athletic field, leadership among peers, and community involvement. Those eligible to apply are students who have achieved a 3.25/4.0 cumulative grade point average (or the equivalent); participate in varsity level (or the equivalent) athletics; and who are attending a high school or who will attend a college that has a Nevco scoreboard, marquee, message center or video display. The scholarships are one-time grants; however, reapplication is encouraged.

For the 2009-2010 academic year, twenty-five (25) \$1,000 awards will be made through the generosity of the Nevco Charitable Foundation.

The following application materials must be provided to the Nevco Charitable Foundation **postmarked by March 31:**

1. Completed, signed **Application**;
2. Typed **Essay**, of at least 350 words, on how your experience as a scholar-athlete will benefit you in the future;
3. **Two letters of Recommendation**, at least one from **a coach**, outlining your contribution to your team, school, family, and community;

Current **High School students** must also provide:

4. Cumulative **Transcript** of academic work through the seventh semester; **and**
5. **Letter of admission** from a college you will attend in the fall.

Current **college students** must also provide:

4. Official, cumulative **Transcript** of academic work through most recently completed term.
